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User Profiles for Regulated HSPs

In an effort to further align with digital health initiatives underway at a provincial level, ClinicalConnect Local Registration Authorities, including physicians acting as their Primary LRA for their Sole Practitionership, are required to update profiles for their regulated health service providers who have access to ClinicalConnect. LRAs (including physicians who are their Primary LRA, for themselves) don't need to complete this exercise for physicians, as physician account holders' College Name (CPSO) and Registration Number (CPSO #) have been auto-populated. In other words, profiles need to be modified for nonphysician, regulated HSPs only. No action with respect to unregulated health service providers who have ClinicalConnect accounts, such as Administrative Support, is required at this time.

The purpose of this exercise is to create a unique identifier for every health service provider who has access to ClinicalConnect and is regulated to practice healthcare through a College recognized by the Ontario Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care. Data from Primary Care CDR Proof of Concept Project to Be Integrated within ClinicalConnect

ClinicalConnect users will soon have the ability to access data being integrated, as part of a separate project, into eHealth Ontario's Primary Care Clinical Data Repository (pcCDR). The build of this repository itself certainly begins to address the need to share primary care data across the continuum of care, and starting this fall, this sub-set of primary care data will be integrated and viewable using

LRAs can populate these two pieces of information easily in AGS using instructions contained in their updated AGS user guide. LRAs can start at any time, but must be complete no later than Friday, October 27, 2017, prior to the next attestation cycle commencing on November 1, 2017.
