ClinicalConnect's Privacy Auditor Training Program

The HITS eHealth Office at Hamilton Health Sciences, Solution Provider for the cSWO Regional Clinical Viewer, ClinicalConnect™, provides all Privacy Auditors from each Participating Organization with training prior to commencing their new role. Training consists of a blended module that begins with a self-directed eLearning module to help Privacy Auditors familiarize themselves with the various privacy components as they relate to ClinicalConnect, an eHealth solution that's been adopted by users at their organization. Privacy Auditors then attend a two-hour webinar that provides a comprehensive overview of how to perform audits in ClinicalConnect, in addition to reinforcing auditing obligations, key privacy and auditing terminology and the definition of a privacy breach and security incidents. Privacy Auditors also gain access to the Auditor SharePoint site that houses a variety of useful resource materials and a discussion forum moderated by the HITS eHealth Office Education Specialist.

All authorized users' access to ClinicalConnect is subject to audit. A ClinicalConnect Privacy Auditor conducts audits in ClinicalConnect on a proactive, reactive and ongoing basis as required, reviews and analyzes audit findings, and then reports those to their organization's Privacy Officer. Random user audits are run on a monthly basis by Privacy Auditors; for smaller organizations with fewer users the Privacy Officer may request the services of the ClinicalConnect Privacy Office in running the audits. A number of proactive and ongoing audit reports are also routinely run by the ClinicalConnect Privacy Office for every Participating Organization. All audit results are tracked, logged and reported to the ClinicalConnect Privacy Advisory Committee on a monthly basis and summarized for the Regional eHealth Steering Committee on a quarterly basis. A number of Privacy & Security policies that conform to the Personal Health Information Protection Act, 2004, apply to auditing in ClinicalConnect. In particular, Privacy Auditors must be familiar with and abide by the Privacy Breach Management, Logging

Some Citrix corporate environments may not support compatible browsers so you may need to launch SWODIN images outside of Citrix.
