NHS Reports Now Being Sent to HRM Via ClinicalConnect

We are pleased to announce that effective June 18, 2015, transcription and radiology reports from Niagara Health System and Hotel Dieu Shaver Health and Rehabilitation Centre are now being sent to OntarioMD's Hospital Report Manager (HRM) via ClinicalConnect.

HRM is enabling clinicians to receive reports electronically in their EMR from hospitals across Ontario. In the HNHB LHIN, we are leveraging the existing technology/platform of ClinicalConnect to push transcriptions and radiology reports from area hospitals to HRM so they are available to participating clinicians across Ontario. Data from other hospitals in the HNHB LHIN are scheduled for integration with HRM starting later in 2015 and through the summer of 2016. ClinicalConnect at the 10th Annual Medical Imaging Informatics and Teleradiology Conference

On June 19, 2015, Dale Anderson, Senior Manager, eHealth at the HITS eHealth Office, presented ClinicalConnect to radiologists and other diagnostic imaging professionals. The conference, held in Hamilton, was arranged by Dr. David Koff, Chief of Diagnostic Imaging at Hamilton Health Sciences and a ClinicalConnect champion. As previously announced, ClinicalConnect now aggregates diagnostic images from 47 acute care hospitals across South West Ontario.

ClinicalConnect is routinely used by diagnostic imaging professionals as it offers health information - particularly Labs and Transcriptions about their patients from other source systems that can be helpful when making diagnoses. The ability to review related diagnostic images and reports about their patients can help to reduce exposure to radiation by not repeating tests unnecessarily.
