# What's Coming Next from ClinicalConnect?

ClinicalConnect is being leveraged to support the rollout of the Province's Hospital Report Manager (HRM) in the Hamilton Niagara Haldimand Brant Local Health Integration Network. In June 2015, using the ClinicalConnect infrastructure, transcription and radiology reports from Niagara Health System are scheduled to begin sending to HRM. HRM is enabling clinicians to receive reports electronically in their EMR from hospitals across Ontario.
