CCAC Care Plans in ClinicalConnect™

We are pleased to announce that the South West and Waterloo Wellington Community Care Access Centres (CCACs) have made the care plans they generate for their clients, as applicable, available in ClinicalConnect. In the CCAC module of ClinicalConnect, an option called "Coordinated Care Plans" in the "View" dropdown menu will appear if the client has a care plan.

At this time, functionality to make care plans from the Erie St. Clair and Hamilton Niagara Haldimand Brant CCACs available in ClinicalConnect is ready. The two CCACs are considering options for how client information relating to care coordination may be made available to ClinicalConnect authorized users. More information will be communicated as it becomes available.

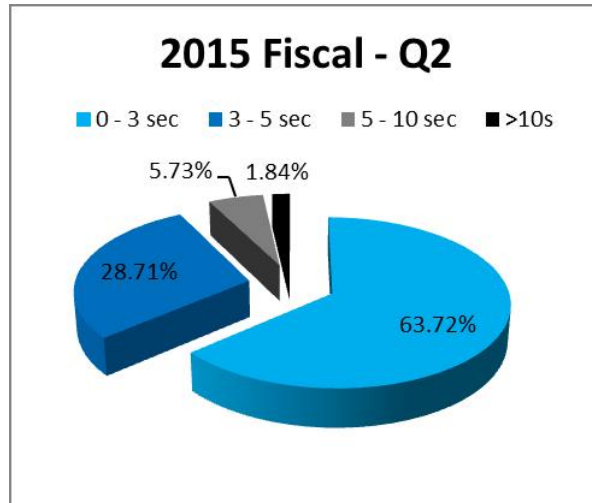

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Between July and September 2015, more than 98% of data requested by users displayed in less than 10 seconds, and 92% of data displayed in less than five seconds. When you compare that to the time you could spend calling around for test results, or waiting for faxes, even at 10 seconds, that's a pretty good response time!
