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What's Next for ClinicalConnect?

Targeted for integration on Wednesday, November 30, diagnostic imaging reports from hospitals outside south west Ontario, followed by their corresponding images and imaging data from Independent Health Facilities (as part of a separate project), will soon be available in ClinicalConnect. Hamilton Health Sciences ClinicalConnect users will be the first to gain access to this new data set, followed by other ClinicalConnect Participating Organizations that have the necessary eHealth Ontario agreement and schedules for services including those schedules for access and for identity management and demonstrated compliance with relevant provincial privacy and security policies. cSWO Change Management & Adoption Delivery Partners will be contacting organizations to facilitate the signing of required documentation so access to the DI Common Service repository via ClinicalConnect can be provisioned.

Semi-Annual Attestations Begin November 1

The semi-annual attestation notification process for the participating organizations of ClinicalConnect will begin on Tuesday, November 1. The purpose of attestations is to periodically check and certify that only the individuals who need certain access privileges to ClinicalConnect and/or the Access Governance System (AGS) have those privileges.

The semi-annual attestation must be performed by various individuals at participating organizations. All data sharing agreement (DSA) signatories must attest that their organization's privacy officer and Local Registration Authorities (LRAs) still hold those roles, privacy officers must attest that their privacy auditors (if applicable) still hold that role, sponsoring physicians attest the staff they sponsor, and LRAs attest their end users access to ClinicalConnect.
