Physicians and Clinicians Making Good Use of C-HOBIC Data in ClinicalConnect

Our logs show that almost 800 clinicians representing Registered Nurses, Nurse Practitioners, Care Coordinators, Physicians and Social Workers have accessed C-HOBIC summary reports that were made available through ClinicalConnect earlier this year. C-HOBIC introduces a standardized approach to the collection of patient information on admission and discharge about the following concepts: functional status, continence, symptom management (pain, nausea, fatigue, dyspnea), number of falls, pressure ulcers and therapeutic self-care (i.e., medication knowledge, ability to manage symptoms and carry out treatments and knowledge of who to contact in an emergency). The collection of this information in a standardized format allows for this summary report of the normalized admission and discharge scores. This report supports planning and management of care as patients transition from one sector of the health care system to another.

C-HOBIC is working with the Hamilton Niagara Haldimand Brant and Waterloo Wellington LHINs Health Links teams to use this report to support of care planning when patients are discharged from acute care. In addition, the C-HOBIC team is planning to survey C-HOBIC data users in the near future. For more information about this initiative please visit http://info.clinicalconnect.ca/modules.

HHS Sovera Health Records now presented as PDFs

Effective September 10, 2014, Hamilton Health Sciences' Health Records which are scanned using a system called Sovera and integrated with ClinicalConnect in the Health Records module, are now presented as PDFs. Previously they were presented as TIFF images but the upgrade to PDF provides greater flexibility to users, since PDFs can be viewed in all web browsers and do not require any additional programs to open. Adobe Reader 10.1.4 or later is recommended to access the Sovera Health Records.
