Three South West Ontario Pharmacies Gain Access to OLIS

Another three ClinicalConnect Participant organizations, representing four sites, have recently been authorized to access data from the Ontario Laboratories Information System (OLIS) using ClinicalConnect. Three of these sites are pharmacies, marking a major milestone because these represent the first pharmacies in the province of Ontario to be able to view this valuable data set using a regional clinical viewer. Together with the cSWO Program and its four Change Management & Adoption Delivery Partners, we look forward to working with additional pharmacies so they too can gain access not only to their patients' community lab data in OLIS, but to their patients' other types of health records, enabling them to delivery more efficient, safer health care.

ClinicalConnect's New User Interface Launches November 4

Come early November, ClinicalConnect users will be presented with a retooled and refreshed version of ClinicalConnect, otherwise referred to as Release 5.0. Launching on November 4, 2017, the new version of ClinicalConnect will provide users with a modernized look and feel, plus increased functionality and enhancements to improve the overall user experience.

Here's a sneak peek at the new user interface! After logging in, users' first stop (once a patient is selected) will be the Patient Dashboard. The Patient Dashboard, by default, is what will first display when accessing a patient's record. It allows users to view multiple clinical modules all at once. This new Patient Dashboard includes a drag and drop feature so users can organize data according to their clinical needs.
