Since the integration of lab data from eHealth Ontario's Ontario laboratories information system (OLIS) with ClinicalConnect in April 2014, work has been ongoing to enable more Participating Organizations' access to this valuable data set. In the last two months, more than 30 organizations including their sites, have had access provisioned following their successful completion of the necessary documentation. In all, 175 Participating Organizations, including their sites, can access OLIS data through ClinicalConnect, with more to come. For ClinicalConnect users, being able to access their patients' lab results from both community-based labs via the OLIS integration, as well as hospital-based labs from all acute care hospitals in South West Ontario that contribute data, represents significant clinical value.
