About ClinicalConnect

- Securely aggregates essential electronic patient care data in real-time from Hospitals, CCACs & Oncology Centres in Southwest Ontario, OLIS, SWODIN, DHDR, DI-CS
- All access by authorized healthcare providers is subject to audit
- Accessible on desktop computers, tablets or mobile devices such as: iPhone™, iPad™, Blackberry™, or Android™
- Settings/preferences can be customized by users
- Physicians in some LHINs have the option to electronically download hospital data into their EMRs
- Single Sign-On and direct launch from select HIS capabilities provide quick and easy access

- Offers 24/7 access to patients' essential health information
- Reduces duplication of tests and procedures, saving time, discomfort and cost
- Improves the transfer of care between healthcare providers and other healthcare organizations
- Provides secure and private access to accurate health information

- Improves coordination across the continuum of care
- Increases patient safety and the quality of care

Key Modules & Functionality

- **Patient Search** conducted by Name, HCN, MRN
 - Advanced Search provides multiple sorting options
- **Patient Lists** provided by inpatient/outpatient locations (Station/Ward/ED)
 - Option to customize Patient Lists using "**My Worklist**"
- Flags identify **Health Links** patients in patient header (currently for HNHB LHIN Health Links patients)
- **New Results** flag new and abnormal results from the last 24, 48 or 72 hours
- **Patient Visits** includes historical and future scheduled appointments
- **Transcription Module** typically includes Discharge, OR, Consult and Progress Notes; can be filtered by **Oncology** progress notes
- **Lab/Microbiology/Pathology & Genetics Modules** include:
 - **Hospital and Ontario Laboratories Information System (OLIS)** lab reports
 - **Lab Module** features graphing & trending capabilities; expanded or list views; results can be filtered by Hematology, Coagulation and Chemistry
 - **Microbiology Module** includes Virology results (Hepatitis, Rubella, CMV & all needle stick Serology tests)
- product and includes column sorting
- **Radiology Module** includes:
 - **Diagnostic Services Reports** (e.g. Radiology, Nuclear Medicine)
 - **Radiology images** from hospitals (check [Integration Chart](#))
- **Pharmacy Module** filters medication orders as: Active, Inactive, On Hold, Discontinued or All. Applies to in-patient hospital pharmacy orders only for selected visits/encounters. Home Meds View lists meds/pharmacy services from DHDR covered by ODB
- **Allergies Module** lists allergies which are also flagged in the patient header
- **Health Records** includes scanned historical health records data from Hamilton Health Sciences and Niagara Health System
- **CCAC Module** includes notes, client demographics, personal & medical contacts, service list, placement list, characteristics, LTCH choices & bookings, community support and other resources, diagnoses, primary care group, risks, safety issues, allergies
- **Resources** include:
