Viewing Data from Digital Health Drug Repository (DHDR) Using ClinicalConnect

We are pleased to announce the following new features related to how data from the Digital Health Drug Repository (DHDR) displays in ClinicalConnect. To view which Participant Organizations are enabled to view data from this provincial data repository, <u>click here</u>.

- DHDR data now presents in two tabs in ClinicalConnect's Pharmacy module Home Med Drugs and Home Med Services - making it easier for users to view clinically-relevant, community-based drug and pharmacy service information
- Drugs with same generic name, dose/strength and dose form now present in rolled-up view that can be expanded to view additional detail
- Users can access and print new DHDR Drug and/or Service reports
- New Drug Utilization Review (DUR) alerts from dispensing pharmacy now viewable
- Additional drug data, including Therapeutic Class and Subclass, plus Prescriber/Pharmacy Phone Number, now available
