

## Summary of Hamilton Health Sciences' Data Display Changes

This document provides an overview of the changes to how Hamilton Health Sciences' data is presented in ClinicalConnect following the hospital's integration with the Epic Hospital Information System. A new "Source" has been added as **"HHSC"** which will include the data that has been brought into Epic. These changes are reflected in the search functions of ClinicalConnect, as well as how the results are displayed in ClinicalConnect's various clinical modules.

### Simple Search

Searching by the patient's name is not available for Hamilton Health Sciences' Epic patient records. Please use the HCN or MRN search option instead.

### Advanced Search

For older Hamilton Health Sciences data, the Source **"Hamilton Area Hospitals"** is still present, with the ability to select a specific Facility. Searching via this Source will include older historical data. All data Haldimand War Memorial Hospital and West Haldimand General Hospital will continue to be available under "Hamilton Area Hospitals" (HHS).

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There is a new "Source" for Hamilton Health Sciences' data in Epic, **"HHSC"**, which does not have any associated facilities available to select.

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Please note that, Last Name, First Name, and Date of Birth (DOB) are required for HHSC "Source" advanced patient search.

### More About the New “HHSC” Source

When viewing data within ClinicalConnect, you may see “HHSC” and “HHS” listed as Sources in your various clinical modules.

Changes to note:

1. When “HHSC” (Epic) is listed as the Source, this will include lab data for patients at St. Joseph’s Healthcare Hamilton, indicated by the applicable St. Joseph’s Healthcare Hamilton facility, as well as oncology data which used to display “HNHB Regional Oncology” as the “Source”.
2. When “HHS” is listed as the Source, this includes data from Haldimand War Memorial Hospital and West Haldimand General Hospital, and these two hospitals will continue to display under this Source.
3. Pathology reports from Hamilton Health Sciences will be available but from OLIS as the Source.

### Other Notes:

- Pathology reports generated at Hamilton Health Sciences (starting Jan 1, 2017) will only be displayed in ClinicalConnect via the portal's integration with the Ontario Laboratories Information System (OLIS). If you are not authorized to view data from OLIS using ClinicalConnect, consider using your EMR's OLIS PQ if available, or contact the ClinicalConnect Program Office by email at [info@clinicalconnect.ca](mailto:info@clinicalconnect.ca) for more information. In the meantime, work continues to have these types of reports viewable by all ClinicalConnect users.
- New results functionality is not available for pathology reports from Hamilton Health Sciences and St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton in the Pathology module. In this case, users will not receive new result notifications if subscribed to the associated MRN.
- Census views, Frequent ED Visits/Microform/VIP Indicator flags, and Mom/Baby link, are not currently supported in ClinicalConnect for HHS' Epic.
- All sites that are part of the HNHB Regional Oncology program, other than Niagara Health's Walker Family Cancer Centre, will now be using Hamilton Health Sciences' Epic for oncology documentation and visits. This data will now display with "HHSC" as the "Source" in ClinicalConnect.
- Radiology reports may require scrolling from left to right to view the complete report, using the scroll bar at the bottom of the report view
- **IMPORTANT: Users are encouraged to set their "Encounter Filter" to "All Regional Encounters" to ensure they're seeing all available data for their patients.**
