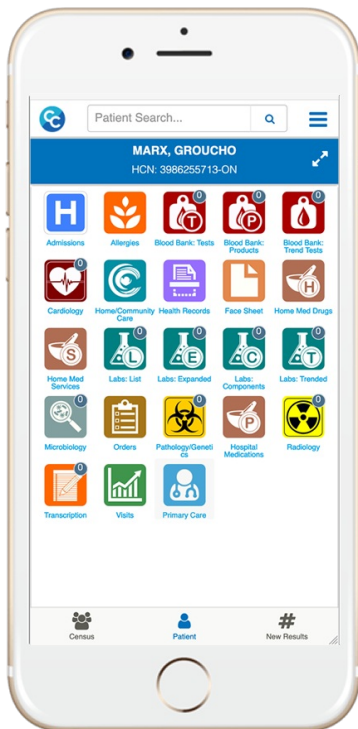

Easily Access ClinicalConnect Data Using Your Mobile Device



Did you know that the ClinicalConnect provider portal is mobile-friendly? Users can view their patients' tests results while on the go and away from a traditional desktop setup. Using the mobile version of ClinicalConnect is easy and the results are highly legible.

There's no application to download – simply visit <https://clinicalconnect.ca> using your mobile device's web browser (ONE ID users can log on through their mobile device by visiting <https://swo.clinicalconnect.ca>). Note that if you're only able to access ClinicalConnect by launching it from your work's health information system, you will not be able to access this web-based instance.

It's also important to note that users will be able to retrieve the same data, including from their authorized provincial repositories, whether accessing ClinicalConnect via a mobile or desktop device.

To make accessing ClinicalConnect even easier on a mobile device, consider [creating a website shortcut on your device's home screen](#) so you can quickly log in.

Viewing HHS' Diagnostic Images in ClinicalConnect

Recently, the eUnity image viewer that was used to view images from Hamilton Health Sciences within ClinicalConnect was decommissioned, and replaced by the GE Centricity image viewer, the same product used to view diagnostic images from all acute care hospitals in South West Ontario.

Did You Know? How to Search for Patient Records Most Efficiently

The most efficient search method is to use the patient's Health Card Number (HCN), which will return data only for that patient (as opposed to patients with the same last name, if searching instead by only Last Name, as an example). This is because ClinicalConnect is searching based on a numeric identifier that is unique to the patient. Using this approach helps increase the speed at which ClinicalConnect can retrieve data from its various source systems by significantly narrowing down the search criteria.

For patients without an HCN, users can search by using the patient's hospital Medical Record Number (MRN), Home and Community Care (HCC) Client Number or by the patient's Name (Last name and at least one letter of the first name).
