Grand River Hospital's new HIS Integrated with ClinicalConnect

We're pleased to announce the successful integration of Grand River Hospital's new Cerner Health Information System.

Users should note that the "Source" column to view data generated at GRH from September 22, 2019 onwards is now called "WW Hub", but does not include Pathology & Genetics, Cardiology, or Blood Bank data at this time.

Data, including Pathology & Genetics, Cardiology, and Blood Bank, generated prior to September 21, 2019 remains available in ClinicalConnect by selecting Grand River Hospital as the "Source". Please note a second phase of this integration between ClinicalConnect and WW Hub's Cerner HIS is expected to go live in early November, which will include the integration of the remaining modules, plus all data from St. Mary's General Hospital which will share this instance of Cerner. Once complete, GRH and St. Mary's General Hospital will appear as Facilities with "WW Hub" as the "Source".

Thank you to our partners at Cerner and Grand River Hospital for their assistance to complete this integration.

Cardiology Module Update

Cardiology-related data that was previously located in either the Radiology and/or Transcriptions modules now appears in ClinicalConnect's Cardiology module following the completion of an integration with the following acute care hospitals:

- Alexandra Marine & General Hospital
- Brant Community Healthcare System
- Cambridge Memorial Hospital
- Huron Perth Health Alliance
- Niagara Health
- Norfolk General Hospital

This adds to the cardiology-related data from Hamilton Health Sciences and London & area hospitals that is already available in ClinicalConnect's Cardiology Module. This type of data from all other acute care data contributors in south west Ontario and the Diagnostic Imaging Common Service (data repository) will remain viewable in ClinicalConnect's Radiology and/or Transcriptions module.

New Timeframes for Participant Organizations Applying for Access

As part of our ongoing effort to help new organizations (excluding Sole Practitioner HIC Participants) gain access to ClinicalConnect and the digital health assets available through it, we have established new timeframe guidelines for the submission of the privacy and security documentation and associated components required to be approved as a Participant Organization.

With the available support of the ClinicalConnect Program Office and the organization's local Delivery Partner team, it's reasonable to expect an organization that is engaged and committed to being approved for access can complete the necessary onboarding requirements within 90 days, which is the new overall timeframe that has been implemented.

In addition, to provide greater clarity, information on how to become a Participant Organization on the ClinicalConnect info site has been separated onto its own page from the Sole Practitioner information and is [available here](#), with a complete breakdown of the steps and deadline for completion.
