New Data Available in ClinicalConnect™

We are pleased to announce that effective May 20, 2015, a variety of new data is available in ClinicalConnect as outlined below:

1. Additional diagnostic images from the Southwestern Ontario Diagnostic Imaging Network (SWODIN) with ClinicalConnect have been integrated. Diagnostic images from the following hospitals in the South West Local Health Integration Network (LHIN) are now available in ClinicalConnect:

To view diagnostic images, click the camera icon in the Radiology Module in ClinicalConnect. Some Citrix corporate environments may not support compatible browsers so you may need to launch SWODIN images outside of Citrix.

2. Scanned and archived Health Records from Niagara Health System now available in the Health Records module in ClinicalConnect.

Scanned and archived Health Records from Niagara Health System (NHS) are now available in the Health Records module of ClinicalConnect. Health Records from NHS complement those already available from Hamilton Health Sciences.
