We are pleased to announce the following integrations with ClinicalConnect are now complete.

1. Data from London, Thames Valley and Regional Hospitals has been successfully integrated with ClinicalConnect. Additional sites now included are:

2. Diagnostic images from St. Mary’s General Hospital as part of the SWODIN integration

We are pleased to announce that diagnostic images from St. Mary’s General Hospital have been successfully integrated with ClinicalConnect. This is the second site to go live as part of the Southwestern Ontario Diagnostic Imaging Network (SWODIN) integration with ClinicalConnect; diagnostic images from Norfolk General Hospital were integrated on July 21. As previously announced,

images from more hospitals will follow in the next phases of this integration. The addition of these images complements the diagnostic imaging reports that are already available in ClinicalConnect.

Please use Internet Explorer 9+, Safari 6.0+, Google Chrome and Firefox when viewing SWODIN images. To view diagnostic images, click the camera icon in ClinicalConnect. Some Citrix corporate environments may not support compatible browsers so you may need to launch the SWODIN images outside of Citrix.

SWODIN connects radiologists, referring physicians and specialists at hospitals across southwestern Ontario, allowing them to instantly access, exchange and store diagnostic images and reports. SWODIN is the first network of its kind in North America to provide access to patient images acquired at multiple facilities using multiple vendor platforms.

3. Radiology reports from St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton are now available through ClinicalConnect's EMR Download

Effective August 20, 2014, Radiology reports from St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton are now available to ClinicalConnect's EMR subscribers. Work is also underway to make Transcription reports from St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton available through EMR Download in the future.

ClinicalConnect is the Regional Clinical Viewer for the connecting South West Ontario (cSWO) Program, funded by eHealth Ontario. Hamilton Health Sciences is the regional service delivery partner deploying ClinicalConnect across the four South West LHINs. The cSWO Program is foundational to eHealth Ontario's commitment to integrate electronic health information for all Ontarians.
