- Complete any outstanding eLearning module(s) you may have in relation to your role. For instance, if you've recently been appointed as Privacy Contact or ClinicalConnect Local Registration Authority for your organization, make sure your orientation is complete. As a reminder, your orientation is completed in the HITS Digital Health Learning Management System at <https://mylearning.hhsc.ca/HDH>. Short-term ClinicalConnect Onboarding Support

As the month comes to an end, we wrap up a short term project whereby the HITS eHealth Office at Hamilton Health Sciences, through funding received by Ontario Health, provided onboarding support to organizations interested in gaining access to ClinicalConnect and/or the provincial data repositories. Our work was initially focused on Ontario Health Team Member Organizations, but grew to support other healthcare providers in south west Ontario expanding the regional value of increased access to electronic health records.

We wish to thank those organizations that went through the process with us, and were able to complete their requirements in a timely fashion. Through these efforts, we welcomed 36 net new Participant Organizations and Sole Practitioners to ClinicalConnect (and the provincial repositories where appropriate), and enabled access to the provincial repositories for 59 others.

Ontario Health have advised that effective March 31, 2021, the Primary Care Data Share (PCDS) Proof of Concept (PoC) project is ending. As such, Ontario Health's Primary Care Clinical Data Repository (pcCDR) will no longer be available resulting in the Primary Care Module in ClinicalConnect also being removed.

Over the past few years, the project successfully integrated primary care data from four Family Health Teams in South West Ontario into the Primary Care Clinical Data Repository (pcCDR), which was viewable via ClinicalConnect by 11 Participant Organizations. The key objective of the proof of concept was to assess the clinical value of sharing primary care data to inform patient care. The project highlighted the enormous importance and benefit of having access to such data, while also identifying improvements to be made, such as enhancing data quality and standardization, in order to optimize the value and use of primary care data. Providing clinicians with access to primary care data will continue to be integral in the development of Ontario's Electronic Health Record (EHR). Ontario Health, in collaboration with the PCDS stakeholders, will be preparing an addendum to the 2019 PCDS final report, with additional lessons learned to support planning for a scalable, permanent, Primary Care data sharing service/document repository. As such, you are encouraged to provide your feedback or questions in relation to having been able to access this primary care data during this proof of concept project by emailing support@clinicalconnect.ca and we will forward your feedback to Ontario Health.

"As a Pathologist working in Bluewater Health's laboratory, when reviewing microscope slides, I use ClinicalConnect to access my patients' pathology reports and other relevant health records generated by hospitals in the region to determine if the disease process I am examining is the same, a new disease or cancer. Having access to these records from sites outside my own is invaluable when assessing difficult cases, especially when the patient is being treated elsewhere, or may have had surgery performed at other institutions.

ClinicalConnect makes it very easy to rapidly obtain information needed to make correct diagnoses, instead of having to contact physicians and/or hospitals, wasting both their time and my own. Similarly, our hospital's staff who are authorized to access ClinicalConnect are able to perform their jobs more efficiently, which in turn helps me in my provision of care to our patients. Overall, using ClinicalConnect helps ensure resources are used more wisely, since it reduces unnecessary repeating of tests.
