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# COVID-19 Vaccine Information from COVax<sub>ON</sub> Now Available Through DHDR in ClinicalConnect


We are pleased to advise that as a result of a recent update to the repository to aggregate vaccination data from  $COVax_{ON}$  (the ministry's provincial solution for COVID-19 vaccination information), COVID-19 vaccine information is now available to ClinicalConnect users at Participant Organizations that are authorized to view data from the provincial Digital Health Drug Repository (DHDR).

COVax<sub>ON</sub> includes information on all COVID-19 vaccinations administered by any health care practitioner in any location in the province; with a subset of the information captured for each vaccination administration provided in near real-time.

If your organization is authorized for DHDR access, and the patient has an Ontario Health Card Number (HCN), you will find COVID-19 vaccination information in ClinicalConnect's Pharmacy module, within the Home Med Drugs tab.

To view COVID-19 vaccination information in ClinicalConnect:

- 1. **Search patient by HCN,** or contextually launch the patient's record from your local HIS/EMR (if applicable).
- 2. Click Pharmacy Module, then "Home Med Drugs" tab. Ensure Encounter filter set to "All Regional Encounters". Optional: Filter on Generic Name or Brand Name columns to locate vaccine data.
- 3. Click on COVID-19 vaccine line item to view associated details as shown in details pane at the bottom (or right) of your screen.

# Expanded Eligibility to Provincial Data Repositories Via ClinicalConnect

The ClinicalConnect Program Office is pleased to advise that new Health Information Custodian (HIC) types have been authorized by the Ministry of Health and Ontario Health to gain access to the provincial data repositories through ClinicalConnect. Specifically, **Ambulance Services** including Community Paramedics, **Home & Community Care Service Providers** (with a Health Regulated Professional), **and Hospices** are the latest HIC types that can now be enabled to view their patients' data from provincially-managed repositories, expanding the data that is currently available through ClinicalConnect, including from acute care sites, LHIN Home & Community Care Services and oncology programs in south west Ontario.

Information made available via these provincial data repositories includes dispensed medications, laboratory results, clinical notes, hospital visits, home and community care services, and diagnostic imaging reports and images.

Engagement is currently underway with those organizations that previously applied for access to repository data, and our HITS eHealth Office Deployment Team is working closely with Ontario Health to identify other ClinicalConnect Participant Organizations that fall within these HIC types that would benefit from access to this additional data.

## Next Version of ClinicalConnect Now Live!

The next release of ClinicalConnect, known as version 5.2, was successfully implemented on May 26th, 2021.

Highlights of the new version include:

- Adding access to Patient Header and Timeline preference settings from within the Patient Header. Look for the 'gear icon' in the Patient Header to be able to adjust how you prefer to view data in ClinicalConnect.
- Building on the existing New Results email notifications, which to date has not been widely
  available to ClinicalConnect users but will be shortly, now users will be required to verify
  the email address they input when subscribing, in ClinicalConnect, to receive these
  notifications. As this New Results notification functionality is deployed more broadly,
  ClinicalConnect users will be notified accordingly, including instructions of how to subscribe
  to these kinds of emails.
- Other back-end portal enhancements to improve system operations.

In addition, for ClinicalConnect users at organizations authorized to view data from the Diagnostic Imaging (DI) Common Service, please be advised that diagnostic images, and their corresponding reports, from Haldimand War Memorial Hospital are now viewable in the portal.

### REMINDER: Semi-Annual Attestations are Due

As a reminder, the purpose of attestations is to periodically check and certify that only the individuals who need certain access privileges to ClinicalConnect and/or the Access Governance System (AGS) have those privileges.
