Data from Additional HNHB LHIN Hospitals Now Being Contributed to Ontario Health Digital Services' Acute & Community Clinical Data Repository

We are pleased to announce that the final phase of the project that's resulted in Radiology and Transcription reports from most hospitals in the Hamilton Niagara Haldimand Brant (HNHB) region being sent, in most cases via Clinical Connect, to the provincial Acute & Community Clinical Data Repository (acCDR) is nearly complete.

In February, Radiology and Transcription reports from St. Joseph's Healthcare Hamilton (SJHH) began sending to the acCDR, and in March, the same type or reports from Norfolk General Hospital also began sending to the acCDR. In addition, configuration work for those reports from Brant Community Healthcare System is also complete with their go-live pending an update to their hospital's data feed.

This project allows healthcare providers across Ontario who don't use ClinicalConnect, but who are authorized to view this repository, to see their patients' transcription reports from most HNHB hospitals, as well as reports from other acCDR contributing organizations. Conversely, data contributed to this repository by healthcare organizations outside SW Ontario can be viewed by authorized organizations using ClinicalConnect.
