IMPORTANT: Optimizing Your User Preferences

On August 15, 2020, a new Preference Setup Wizard was implemented in ClinicalConnect. As a result of this enhancement, you have the ability to set up separate preference options when using ClinicalConnect on desktop vs. mobile devices, as well as when using the Patient Dashboard. If you haven't yet done so, please take a moment to verify that the current preferences associated with each of these three modalities (desktop, mobile and Dashboard) are as desired, given each has its own set of preferences to choose from.

In addition, it's very important that in each of the three modalities:

- The **Encounter Filter** be set to "**All Regional Encounters**" to ensure data from provincial repositories is viewable (assuming your organization has been enabled to view such data).
- The **Days Back Filter** should be set to an appropriate number of days.
- For the Patient Dashboard, the two filters mentioned above should be set using the Preference Setup Wizard to ensure that the modules you have selected to display in your Dashboard present the desired amount of data. You can also set and save preferences for the modules in their Dashboard individually by clicking the Preference (gear) icon within each Dashboard module's window.

ESC Region HIS Reintegration - Phase 1 Now Live

We are pleased to advise that ClinicalConnect is now integrated with the new Hospital Information System (HIS) being used by certain hospitals in the Erie St. Clair (ESC) region.

With phase one of this change, data generated by Erie Shores HealthCare (formerly Leamington District Memorial Hospital) as of September 26, 2020, now displays in ClinicalConnect with "ESC Region" as the "Source". Any data generated prior to this data remains viewable, but lists Leamington District Memorial Hospital as the "Source".

Future phases are planned for "ESC Region" data contribution, beginning in November through until April 2021, with Chatham-Kent Healthcare Alliance, Hotel Dieu Grace Healthcare and Windsor Regional Hospital integrating their data into this regional view.

In addition, as part of this integration project, the ability to contextually launch ClinicalConnect directly from ESC Region's new HIS has been configured and will be deployed by the hospitals to their ClinicalConnect users.

Thank you to our partners for their work to integrate ClinicalConnect with this new HIS implementation in ESC region.

EMAIL NOTIFICATIONS NOW LIVE for Hamilton Health Sciences Users!

We are pleased to announce the release of eNotifications, as the next phase of our version 5.1 update. This new functionality is now available to Hamilton Health Sciences' authorized ClinicalConnect users and broader deployment of this new functionality will follow.

As a reminder, enabled ClinicalConnect users can subscribe to receive email alerts (for select modules) when new results become available in their patients' record; no Personal Health Information (PHI) or Personal Information (PI) is included in the email itself. This notification functionality is built on the existing New Results module which aggregates new results from direct data integrations with select acute care hospitals in south west Ontario; provincial repository data does not currently support the New Results/Notifications feature.
