**Updates to the London, Thames Valley & Regional Hospitals'
Integration with ClinicalConnect Complete**

We are pleased to announce that additional data and functionality related to London, Thames Valley and Regional Hospitals (LTVH) has been added to ClinicalConnect as outlined below.

- Pharmacy data - Pharmacy data from LTVH is now available through ClinicalConnect. The Pharmacy module displays lists of patient medication orders which may be filtered by status type. In addition, the medication list can be filtered to show Active/On Hold Meds at Discharge which may be useful for clinicians providing care to patients post-discharge.
- New Results indicators - New Results indicators have been added for LTVH patient data, where the number of new test results from the last 24, 48 or 72 hours will be flagged beside the names of select modules in ClinicalConnect. These new results will also appear in the New Results module, providing users with an efficient snapshot of recent test results for treatments performed at LTVH.
- Simple Search functionality - Simple Search functionality for patients seen at an LTVH hospital is now available in ClinicalConnect. Simple Search allows users to search for patients by entering their name, Medical Record Number (MRN) or Health Card Number (HCN).
- Additional Transcriptions, including changes to presentation format - Building on the initial integration of patient data from LTVH with ClinicalConnect announced on August 20, 2014, we are pleased to announce that additional types of transcriptions are now available in ClinicalConnect and that all transcriptions from LTVH are now presented as PDF documents.

Our thanks to the team at London Health Sciences Centre for their assistance in bringing these updates to their hospital system's integration with ClinicalConnect to fruition.
